Kathryn (Kat) Sherman is a jazz vocalist, composer, arranger, and teaching artist based in Chicago, IL. She has released recordings with jazz bassist Hannah Marks (Alone Together) and math rock band Giraffe House (Passenger, Leafy Greens, Toxic, Folding Chair Fathers), and has been a featured vocalist on recordings with the University of North Texas Jazz Singers (dir. Jennifer Barnes), the Two O'Clock Lab Band (dir. Rob Parton), and with independent artists.

Her compositions and arrangements have been performed by ensembles across the United States and Australia by award-winning vocal jazz and show choir programs, and in 2025, Kat was commissioned by the Jazz Education Network to compose a piece to be premiered at their 2026 conference.

A passionate educator, Kat is on the Jazz Studies faculty at DePaul University, teaching applied jazz voice, jazz ear training, jazz piano class, and directing the Downbeat award-winning DePaul Vocal Jazz Ensemble.
